## Canine Schedule

**Canine schedule highly recommended, Core Vaccines are shown in Maroon.**

**6 weeks:**

**Corona/Parvo Combination Vaccine**

**8 weeks:**

**Distemper/Adeno/Lepto/Parainfluenza + Corona ("DA2LPP+C")**

**12 weeks:**

**DA2LPP+C**

**Rabies Vaccine**

**Kennel Cough Complex (injection)**

**Lyme Disease**

**16 weeks:**

**DA2LPP+C**

**Kennel Cough Complex (intranasal)**

**Rabies**

**6 - 12 months:**

**Kennel Cough Complex (booster)**

**Annually Rabies Vaccine (booster)**

**Vaccination against Giarrdia is recommended for dogs having poor immune systems, if exposure is likely.**

**Vaccinations for ringworm are only occasionally used when an animal is not responding to normal treatment.**
